

Rohit Das MD MPH is Chief of Neurology at VA Portland Healthcare System, which is one of the largest neurology VA sections with 28 staff neurologist and more than six neurology fellows. He is also Professor of Neurology at the Oregon Health and Science University in Portland Oregon. Previously he was Associate Professor at UT Southwestern and Assistant Professor at Indiana and University of Louisville. He received neurology residency training at Boston University and fellowship training in epilepsy at Harvard Medical School.

An accomplished physician educator and physician executive, Dr Das has the unique distinction of being the only person to found two separate MD/MPH programs, one at Indiana University and University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center. He has served as Systems Based Practice Competency Director, Neurology Clerkship Director, Course Director of multiple medical school courses and in leadership positions at the American Epilepsy Society and the United Council for Neurological Specialties. He is the author of more than forty publications and has spoken at numerous institutions and societies.
